## **Band Boosters General Information**

### **PURPOSE STATEMENT**

*“Proud of our past, and dedicated to our future.”*

### **MISSION STATEMENT**

The CVHS Marching Band is an educational arts program dedicated to providing our youth of our high school and community with the means to develop life skills, musical skills, performance skills, build character and foster teamwork while cultivating the talents of tomorrow’s leaders.

### **Welcome**

We are the Cumberland Valley Band Boosters. We would like to thank you for taking the opportunity to understand both the Cumberland Valley Marching Band and the Band Boosters role in contributing to its success.

The object of the Cumberland Valley Band Boosters is 1) to arouse and maintain an enthusiastic interest in the various phases of the Instrumental Music Department of the Cumberland Valley School District, 2) to lend all possible support, both moral and financial, to the general instrumental music programs in the schools, and 3) to build and maintain an organization which will help promote the activities of the Instrumental Music Department.

Parents of band members are automatically included as Band Boosters. It is however, not necessary to have a student in the band to be an active Booster. Anyone interested in supporting the Instrumental Music Department of the high school may join. Our main functions are fund-raising and support. The Band Boosters manage an annual budget in order to support the Marching Band Program and the overall Instrumental Music Department. We do not make any policy decisions for the band or band staff.

Each year the School District pays for the Band Director, the assistance Band Director and Guard Director salaries and a portion of other expenses (for example, bus transportation for football games and competitions plus dry cleaning for band uniforms). The Band program, however, has many additional costs to keep our students on the field. The Band Boosters coordinate volunteers for all fall and winter events including chaperones, ‘manning’ the concession stands/Fry wagon, building and transporting props, and supplying truck & trailer drivers for all events. In addition, the band boosters provide financial support for show design and instruction costs. The Boosters pay for ~20 outdoor and ~10 indoor technical assistants, instructors, drill writers, etc. The boosters also fund color guard uniforms, flags, rifles, and sabers; maintenance of and repairs to our band ‘fleet’ including our equipment truck, pickup truck, small trailer, uniform trailer and Fry wagon; plus auto and liability insurance; and the rental or buying of many of our large instruments. In addition, the band boosters organize and fund meals for our students and families for the parent preview and ACC finals, plus dinners for our students on Saturdays when we have all day practices plus competitions. We also fund costs associated with senior night, the band banquet and scholarships for graduating seniors.

The information on the following pages will familiarize you with our organization, its functions, projects, and committees. Because the band is so large, it is difficult to contact everyone personally. Any questions you may have can be directed to any Band Booster Officer, Committee Chairperson, or the Band Director.

The CVBB Constitution and By-laws can be found on our web site [www.cvhs-band.org](http://www.cvhs-band.org). Our year runs from January 1 through December 31. Election of Officers is held in December of each year and they assume their duties in January.

### Supporting the Marching Band

The CVBB is an active organization creating a positive experience for our students by supporting the Marching Band program. **This takes many parents helping** to maintain the activities that generate the funds to make this a successful program. Our organization has some general fundraising programs that have continued to be successful sources of revenue for the CVBB.

### Concession Stands at the Football Stadium

The Concession Stands were built by the CV Band Booster organization. They are open for all home Varsity Games, other sports events in the stadium, and the CV Band Competition, 'Echoes in the Valley'. **They are staffed by parents of the band members** and sell a wide variety of hot & cold food, drinks, and snacks.

### The Fry Wagon

The famous Fry Wagon is another way of raising money for the CV Band Booster yearly budget. The Fry Wagon is **staffed by parents of band members** and is at all the Home Varsity Football games and other CV and community events throughout the year. The Fry Wagon is staffed by CVBB and sells French fries, chicken fingers, and on occasion, hot dogs, sausages, hamburgers, water, soda, and candy.

### Echoes in the Valley

Echoes in the Valley is the marching band competition hosted by the CV Band Boosters on a Saturday evening in October at the CV's Chapman Field. This year's competition is scheduled for Oct 6, 2012. The students practice their show during the day and later are served dinner courtesy of CVBB. At the event, we host other schools and our band gives the closing performance to the competition. Meanwhile, the parents work in the concession stands; escort the visiting bands; sell programs, admission tickets, candy-grams, flower-grams, buttons; and feed the judges. We need everyone's help!

## Echoes in the Dome

Echoes in the Dome is an indoor guard and percussion competition hosted by the CV Band Boosters on a Saturday in March or April in the CV gym or 'Dome'. This year's competition was April 28, 2012. Next year's program is scheduled for March 23, 2013. Similar to the Echoes in the Valley, we host other school guard, dance and percussion groups in a competition. And the boosters work the concession stand; escort the visiting groups; sell programs, admission tickets, candy-grams, flower-grams, buttons; and feed the judges. We need everyone's help!

## The Band Trip

The Band Trip normally occurs during a Holiday Break every other year, 2010, 2012 etc. Although the trip is not a requirement to participate in the marching unit, most students do participate in the trip. While all trips require School Board approval, the trip is completely funded by the students & CVBB. The band participates in a competition or parade chosen by the Band Director, somewhere in the US, during Christmas or Thanksgiving break. The cost of the trip ranges from \$1,000 - \$1,500 depending on where the band is going and the length of the trip. We schedule the trip for approximately 1 week and include sightseeing events as well. Chaperones pay their own way. This year we are planning to travel to Disney World over the Thanksgiving break.

## The Band Banquet

Each year we celebrate the 'season' with a Band Banquet. This year our Band Banquet will be January 4th, 2013 at the Radisson in Camp Hill. The banquet is for the students of the marching band and their parents. The banquet begins at 6 pm with dinner served at 6:30. Following dinner there are some remarks and the students are recognized and receive their awards by 'class'. Dancing is scheduled with a DJ from approximately 9pm to 11pm. Dress code is the same as Homecoming and Gala. Students are not allowed to change clothes for the dance and they may not return after leaving the premises.

## Student Accounts

The Student Account is where the students' Fund Raising money is credited. Any student who chooses to raise funds via the Student Fund Raisers will split the profit 80/20 with 80% going to the student and the remaining 20% to the 'Booster' organization to help defray costs. The Treasurer maintains student accounts for all active members. The money held within this account is used for band purposes only. The student accounts can be used for major band trips, the annual band banquet, band apparel, and any other mandated band expense. Student account information is available each month at the general booster meeting for your review to ensure the account balance matches your records.

To maintain a student account you must be in 8th grade or higher. Seniors must liquidate their accounts by the **end of May** of their senior year. If not liquidated, any balance will be transferred into the Boosters' General Fund. If a student does not return the next season, their account must be liquidated by September 30<sup>th</sup>. For example, if a student participated as a freshman, elected not to participate as a sophomore, they must liquidate their account by September 30<sup>th</sup> coming into their sophomore year. If not liquidated their account by September 30<sup>th</sup>, any balance will be transferred into the Boosters' General fund.

Options for liquidation are the following:

1. Transfer to general fund
2. Transfer to benevolent fund
3. Transfer to any budget line item
4. Transfer to another active band member

### **Check Writing**

When writing checks to the booster club, please make checks payable to “CVBB” (Cumberland Valley Band Boosters). In addition, it’s very important to write the student’s full name and purpose of the check in the memo line. This will assist the treasurer and assistant treasurer account for the funds coming into the organization.

### **Common Terms:**

**Band Box:** This is the box located in the high school band room where forms and fundraiser orders are returned. This white box is located directly inside the door to the band room on the left.

**Dinkles:** Shoes worn by all band students that are ordered usually during band practice in the spring. Distribution is normally during band camp.

**Drill:** The actual movement from one place on the field to another done in the form of ‘Sets’ or pictures of what the show is to look like at any given time.

**Gloves and Socks:** Black gloves and socks are worn every time the uniform is worn and may be ordered with the dinkles, grays etc.

**Blacks:** Consist of a T-shirt and shorts (formerly known as grays) worn under the band uniform at all times to protect the band uniform and are ordered at the same time as the dinkles.

**Guard Uniform:** Consists of the actual performance uniform, matching body suit and a running suit for before and after performances.

**Summer Uniform:** Consists of Black dress pants (Cargo pants and pants with pockets or zippers at the knees are NOT acceptable) and a Red ‘Band’ Polo shirt. Polo shirts are ordered with the dinkles, grays etc.

**Wind Breakers:** Lined hooded wind breaker which has the band logo on the back and is a required item for football games, parades and competitions when the band uniform isn’t worn. These are ordered with the dinkles and grays.

## Marching Band Fundraising

### Student Fundraisers

**TYPICAL STUDENT FUNDRAISER:** To help defray the cost for your son or daughter, consider participating in a **student** fundraiser. They help to pay for:

- The 2012 CV Marching Band Trip to Disney World
- The 2012 Indoor Trip to Wildwood, NJ
- Clothing – band coat, jacket, polo shirt, gloves, shoes etc
- Band Banquet, trophies, drum major camp and more

Our goal is to hold between 8 and 10 during the year, but this is dependent on a parent willing to organize each fundraiser. A wide variety of products will be available throughout the year for fundraising. You choose the ones that are right for you. Students sell a product over a two to three week period. Every time you sell something for a fundraiser, 80% of the profit will go into your Student Account. The account balance is carried over from year to year allowing students to build their balance on ‘non trip’ years. Upcoming student fundraisers include:

**ECHOES ADS:** Another student fundraiser is selling program ads to local businesses and organizations for our annual CV Marching Band Competition; it's named Echoes in The Valley. It's held every October so students are busy selling ads in July and August. Students net 80% of the Echoes ads that they sell!

**GROCERY CARDS:** Ongoing Giant, Karns, and Weis Food Gift Cards (5% of total purchase). In addition to groceries, these cards can be used for gas (Giant) or to purchase other gift cards for local businesses or restaurants. Orders for the cards are taken a week or two before each monthly booster meeting and then paid for and distributed at the monthly booster meeting. ## Marching Band Schedule

**Marching Band is a credited course.** Beginning with the 2012-13 school year, students in the CVMB will earn .25 elective credit as long as they do what is required to pass the course. Marching Band will be a pass/fail course; students will not receive a numerical grade, leaving their overall GPA unaffected. It will, however, satisfy the requirements for .25 credit of an elective for each year of participation. The idea is that over a 4-year period, students can satisfy 1 elective credit requirement. This will enable students to have slightly more free time during their daily school schedule than in years past.

The curriculum is currently being written, so final details regarding grading will be available with the syllabus. A general guideline that can be expected, however, will consist of drill checks, music/work checks, and participation. Wind players, battery percussionists, pit percussionists, and color guard spinners will each have their own separate rubrics for their specific areas.
