MISSION STATEMENT

The CVHS Marching Band is an educational arts program dedicated to providing our youth of our high school and community with the means to develop life skills, musical skills, performance skills, build character and foster teamwork while cultivating the talents of tomorrow’s leaders.

Welcome

We are the Cumberland Valley Band Boosters. We would like to thank you for taking the opportunity to understand both the Cumberland Valley Marching Band and the Band Boosters role in creating a successful music program.

Who are the Band Boosters?

The Cumberland Valley Band Boosters (CVBB) is organized to support the Music Department of our high school. Parents of band members are automatically included as Band Boosters. It is however, not necessary to have a student in the band to be an active Booster. Anyone interested in supporting the Music Department of the high school may join. Our main functions are fund-raising and support. The Band Boosters manage an annual budget in order to support the Marching Band Program and the overall Music Department. We do not make any policy decisions for the band or band staff.

Since the Marching Band activities are costly and not completely covered by the School Board Budget, it is primarily a self-funded program overseen by the CVBB. Being that CVBB is a support function for the Marching Band, it is responsible for an annual budget that raises money to support the Marching Band through Concession stands, Fry Wagon events and numerous other fundraisers. The money we raise helps supply the marching band with equipment, props, trucks and the trailers needed to transport organization to competitions and football games, and other events.

The information on the following pages will familiarize you with our organization, its functions, projects, and committees. Because the band is so large, it is difficult to contact everyone personally. Any questions you may have can be directed to any Band Booster Officer, Committee Chairperson, or the Band Director.

The CVBB Constitution and By-laws can be found on the web site www.cvhs-band.org. Our year runs from January 1 through December 31. Election of Officers is held in December of each year and they assume their duties in January.

What is the ‘Band Web Site’?

www.cvhs-band.org, mark it & keep it handy! Information available on the web site includes: CVBB Committee contact info, upcoming event & performance information, practice schedules, fundraisers, email contacts, etc. We continue to work on making this the ‘*go to place*’ for information.

Supporting the Marching Band

The Cumberland Valley Band Boosters (CVBB) is an active organization creating a positive experience for our students by supporting the Marching Band program. **This takes many parents helping** to maintain the activities that generate the funds to make this a successful outcome. Our organization has some general fundraising programs that have continued to be successful sources of revenue for the CVBB.

‘Concession Stands’ at the Football Stadium

The Concession Stands were built by the CV Band Booster organization. They are open for all home Varsity Games, other sports events in the stadium, and the CV Band Competition, ‘Echoes in the Valley’. **They are staffed by parents of the band/guard members** and sell a wide variety of hot & cold food, drinks, and snacks.

Why are we at the other sporting events selling food?

There are many sporting events going on at a community level within the school district. Softball, Baseball, Soccer Tournaments, etc. are sports groups and are not set-up to run food concessions. Because we are, CVBB is often requested to handle the food concessions.

What is “Echoes in the Valley”?

Commonly referred to as Echoes, is the marching band competition hosted by the CV Marching Band on a Saturday evening in September or October at the CV Football field. The students practice their show in the afternoon and later are served dinner courtesy of CVBB. At the event, we host other schools and our band gives the closing performance to the competition. Meanwhile, the parents work the concession stands, escort the visiting bands, sell programs, admission tickets, candy-grams, flower-grams, buttons, and coordinate the judges and feed them too. We need everyone’s help!

What is the ‘Fry Wagon’?

The famous Fry Wagon is another way of raising money for the CV Band Booster yearly budget. The Fry Wagon is **staffed by parents of band/guard students** and is at all the Home Varsity Football games, Silver Spring Wal-Mart on various weekends, and numerous other CV Athletic & community events throughout the year. The Fry Wagon is staffed by CVBB and sells French fries, chicken fingers, and on occasion, hot dogs, sausages, hamburgers, water, soda, and candy.

What other types of general fundraising do you do?

In the past we have sold ads on the side of our uniform trailer and fry wagon, t-shirts and sweatshirts, held a basket bingo, raffle ticket sales, and chicken dinner events. These are just examples of opportunities we take to meet our annual budget. Any ideas are greatly appreciated.

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Volunteers

Volunteering is an important aspect in the operation of the CVBB organization. The success our volunteers have in effectively running events throughout the year provides our students with the best times of their lives. Volunteering should demonstrate to our children the importance and understanding that committing our time for them and others is a valuable reward in itself.

What is a ‘Student Account’?

The Student Account is where the students’ Fund Raising money is credited. We no longer have a participation fee of \$150.00 for the Marching Band program that each student needs to raise during the year. However, any student who chooses to raise funds via the Student Fund Raisers will split the profit 80/20 with 80% going to the student and the remaining 20% to the ‘Booster’ organization to help defray costs. The money, held within this account, is to be used for the student’s purposes only. The student accounts can be used for sponsored Marching band trips, such as major trips, or items such as marching band apparel. To maintain a student account you must be in 8th grade or higher. Seniors must liquidate their accounts by the end of April of their senior year. If not liquidated, any balance will be transferred into the Boosters’ General Fund. If a student does not return to marching band the next season, their account must be liquidated by September 30th.

Options for liquidation are the following:

- Transfer to general fund
- Transfer to benevolent fund
- Transfer to any budget line item
- Transfer to another active marching band member

Check Writing

When writing checks to the booster club, please make checks payable to “CVBB” (Cumberland Valley Band Boosters). In addition, it’s very important to write the student’s full name and purpose of the check in the memo line. This will assist the treasurer and assistant treasurer account for the funds coming into the organization.

What is the ‘Band Trip’?

The Band Trip normally occurs during a Holiday Break every other year, 2006, 2008, etc. While all trips require School Board approval, it is completely funded by the students & CVBB. The band

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participates in a competition or parade chosen by the Band Director, somewhere in the US, during Christmas or Thanksgiving break. We schedule the trip for 1 week and include sightseeing events as well. Chaperones pay their own way.

What are the Fundraisers?

The fund raising committee welcomes you to the exciting world of CVHS Marching Band! To help defray the cost of the 'Band Trip' the fund raising committee was established. The cost of the trip ranges from \$1,200 - \$1,500 depending on where the band is going and the length of the trip. A wide variety of products will be available throughout the year for fundraising. You choose the ones that are right for you. A student account is established for each marching band member. The account balance is carried over from year to year allowing student to build their balance on 'non trip' years. Every time you sell something for a fundraiser, 80% of the profit will go into your Student Account.

All sales run for at least two weeks, usually beginning and ending on Tuesdays. All order forms can be turned in to the fund-raising committee or placed in the white mailbox in the high school band room. All fund-raisers are pre-paid with 1 check (*no cash*) and payment must accompany the order. Checks should be made payable to CVBB. You will find a cover letter attached to each fund-raiser providing the fundraiser details, which are also listed on the web site.

Profits will be credited to your student's account by coordination between Treasurer, Asst. Treasurer and the fund-raiser committee member. Student account information is available each month at the general booster meeting for your review to ensure the account balance matches your records.

Common Terms:

Band Box: This is the box located in the high school band room where forms and fundraiser orders are returned. This white box is located directly inside the door to the band room on the left.

Dinkles: Shoes worn by all band students and are ordered usually during band practice in the spring. Distribution is normally during band camp.

Drill: The actual movement from one place on the field to another done in the form of 'Sets' or pictures of what the show is to look like at any given time.

Gloves and Socks: Black gloves and socks are worn every time the uniform is worn and may be ordered with the dinkles, grays etc.

Grays: Consist of a T-shirt and shorts worn under the band uniform at all times to protect the band uniform and are ordered at the same time as the dinkles.

Guard Uniform: Consists of the actual performance uniform, matching body suit and a running suit for before and after performances.

Summer Uniform: Consists of Black dress pants (Cargo pants and pants with pockets or zippers at the knees are NOT acceptable) and a Red 'Band' Polo shirt. Polo shirts are ordered with the dinkles, grays etc.

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Wind Breakers: Lined hooded wind breaker which has the band logo on the back and is a required item for football games, parades and competitions when the band uniform isn't worn. These are ordered with the dinkles and grays.
